Course Description

ACT's Introduction to Photography Course focuses on teaching students the basics of digital photography. The course focus enables each student to learn the fundamental functions of a digital camera, and the editing software required to create a completed image. Students will be exposed to all the elements of photography in order to show them how a successful image is composed.
